

Dragon

The symbol of Wales, its origin lost in the breath of time.

Dimensions:

3mx 3mx 3m

The ten-foot part-flying, part-running dragon is the centrepiece. It is part lifelike and part abstract assembled by the viewer's eye.

The dragon is red on the inside representing its spirit, assuming character is more important than outward appearance.

There are miniature red dragons along the length of its spine

Tongue symbols are carved along the length of the spine below the dragons. These are the symbol of the Welsh Language Society.

The wings are in the colours of the Welsh National flag: red, green and white, again adopting the tongue pattern.

"Draig" is inscribed in the back of the dragon's head.

The dragon was developed through eighteen months of drawings, prototypes and other
